Please join SMPTE Toronto Section's first meeting after the 2016 summer break with two very interesting presentations.

First off, we have our always popular **IBC Wrap-up**. IBC 2016 will have come and gone by September 20th. Two renowned individuals from the Canadian Broadcast Engineering community will be fresh off their planes from Amsterdam and will enlighten our members with a full report on what went down at IBC 2016. On hand for this portion of our evening will be **Paul Briscoe, Broadcast Technology Consultant** and **SMPTE Standards Committee Member**, as well as **Stan Moote, CTO** with the **International Trade Association for Suppliers of Broadcast and Media Technology (IABM)**.

Our second presentation is a look at an **Innovative Approach to Restoring an Incomplete Film**. **Taylor Whitney, President and Founder of Preserving The Past LLC** in Rochester, New York has worked in the film production and film preservation arena for more than 24 years. As a Senior Film Inspection Technician she assisted on the film restoration team of Robert Harris and Jim Katz (Lawrence of Arabia, My Fair Lady), on Rear Window, Vertigo, The Man Who Knew too Much, and Trouble with Harry. Taylor will explain the processes and challenges of taking a film project that got off the ground but never quite took flight. She will speak about all the issues required to take an unfinished film project and complete it for the small screen.
